Principal Report:	<p>SSP – We continue to focus on our writing and math goals in each classroom. We are starting to see a difference with students writing stamina. Wellness Wednesdays continue to be a great success each month. Students are sharing some ideas for what they would like to see for future Wellness Wednesdays. Walking Club also continues to be a huge success. We are offering this three mornings a week. Students have the choice of going to the gym for walking club or staying in their classrooms for a softer start. To support the Wellness Goal, members from the HRCE equity team will be visiting the school after Christmas to provide some professional development.</p> <p>Halloween Howl was a huge success again this year. Attendance was great, the majority of the school community supported this event. The Grade 6's once again lead this event again. They were wonderful leaders and raised a great amount towards their year end trip.</p> <p>The Remembrance Day assembly was a very thoughtful event. The Elmsdale Legion supported the school. There were several members that attended the</p>

The school laid a wreath at the Elmsdale Cenotaph on November 11th.</p> <p>Our final fire drill of the Fall took place during recess time. The school was able to evacuate the students that were still in the building and gather the students that were outside in a very timely manner. One thing that was learned was that the fire alarms cannot be heard outside. Whistles were purchased and placed in each fire bag to support an evacuation such as this.</p> <p>The vision statement and Behaviour Expectations Matrix continues to be reinforced in classrooms as well as at monthly assemblies. At the assemblies the matrix is broken down with a small section being the focus for the month.</p> <p>Tina Richard and Laura King attended the SAC Provincial Conference on November 28th. They attended sessions regarding grants, the hot lunch program and the Provincial School Code of Conduct.</p> <p>SAC Funding has been deposited into our accounts. We currently have \$5909.71 in the account for this school year. We transferred \$1000 into the playground improvement fund as we our discussions last year.</p>
